HOW TO ACCESS THE NATIONAL TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT CURRICULUM ON CAPLEARN FOR PARENTS

CapLEARN is an official website of the United States government and Learning Management System (LMS) that provides access to training, knowledge, and skills to build child welfare capacity through learning. Your first step in accessing the National Training and Development Curriculum (NTDC) on CapLEARN is to go to https://learn.childwelfare.gov/ Once there, you must register to create a CapLEARN account.





To create a CapLEARN account you will compete a form which captures your name, email address and other additional information. CapLEARN was primarily created with child welfare professionals in mind, therefore some of the questions are not going to be relevant to you as a parent. You are only required to answer questions with a red asterisk^{*}. In order to successfully complete the registration process to create your CapLEARN account, below are suggested default answers to provide for those questions that may not apply to you.

In Section 1 please consider the following selections if you are a parent registering:

In Section 2 choose "- None -" or check "Non Applicable" as appropriate



In Section 3 choose "Not Applicable" at the bottom of the lists of states .

In Section 4 choose "Not Applicable" as appropriate.



Once you have completed the form, click on

Create new account in the bottom right hand corner.

A box will appear midway down the screen indicating that you should check your email for further instructions.

Further instructions have been sent to your e-mail address.

You will receive an email from the CapLEARN Website with the subject: CapLEARN Account Details. Open this email to confirm your registration and activate your account by clicking on the enclosed link. You are prompted to validate your email address and then you are logged into the site one time so that you can reset/select a new password.
